Following on from the success of last years Christmas Bizarre, we are extending an open invitation to craftspeople, designer makers and fine artists to participate in an even bigger Hall of Stalls Art and Craft Fair running over three days, **Friday 10th, Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th December.**

This year the emphasis will be on the stalls with free admission to the craft fair and to the performance events. The café will be open all day, there is free parking for exhibitors and visitors and a private viewing for your buyers on the Friday.

Last year we had a good variety of excellent work. We would like to maintain this standard and are asking you to submit three images on CD that represent the work you would want to show together with this form.

You will need to commit to attending the whole event. The fee is £80 in total, and you will need to pay a minimum non-refundable deposit of £25 for your stall before **Friday 29th October**, and the balance of £55 before **Friday 4th December**. If you wish to share a stand you will need to complete separate entry forms, but send them in together, clearly stating that it is a joint application.

We will provide wall space and a table with ambient lighting, but you may wish to embellish this with spotlights and stands. There will be 1 plug socket available per stall.

Please complete the entry form and return to us as soon as possible. Your table will be reserved as soon as we have receipt of your deposit. The final deadline for submissions will be **Friday 29th October**.

The deadline for applications is **Friday 29th October 2010**. Your application will be assessed by The School Creative Centre with consultation from Melanie Powell (Arts Development Officer for Rother District Council) and Sarah Money (Rye Art Gallery).
